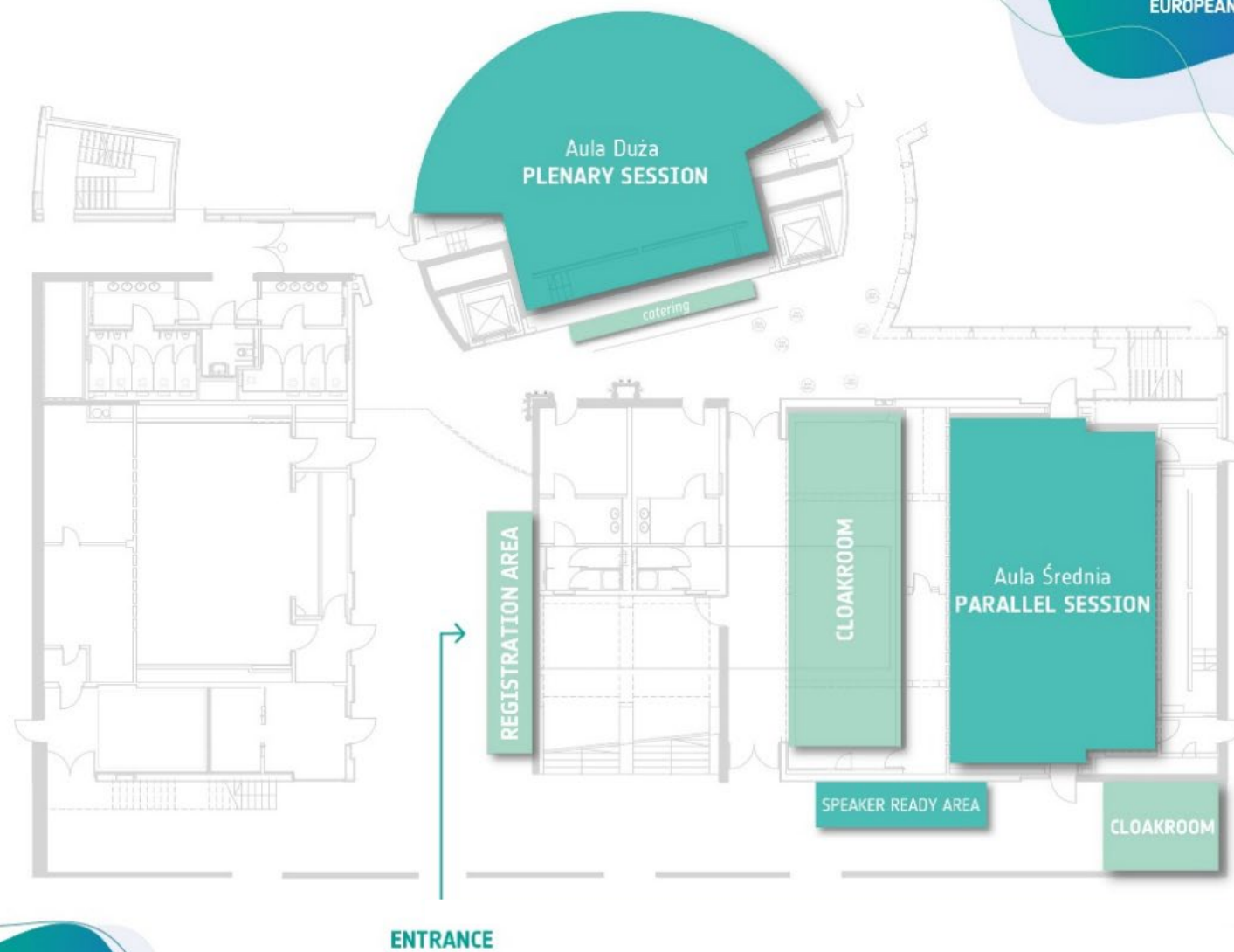

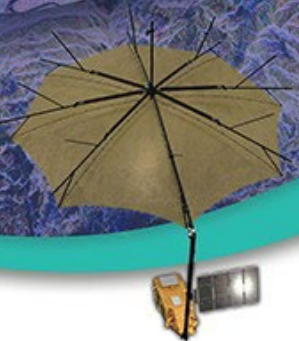




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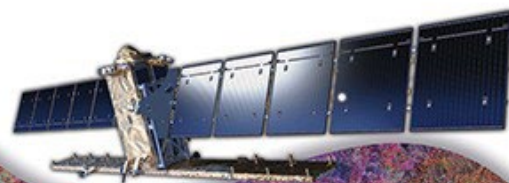

Speaker Instructions:

- Authors are requested to prepare a 15-minute oral presentation, allowing a few additional minutes for Questions & Answers after each presentation
- Presentations may be uploaded to the dedicated laptop in the Speaker Ready Area at any time from the start of the conference, but no later than 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the session
- Presentations will be launched by a technician. Speakers are only required to advance their slides using the slide-advance device available at the podium. Session chairs will provide a two-minute warning before the end of the allocated presentation time.

Poster Presentations

- 2 Poster Sessions, on Tuesday & Thursday afternoons at the poster session areas on Floor 2, from 16:30 to 19:00;
- Poster mounting starts on Monday during the 1st coffee break for the poster session 1 and authors of **Poster Session 1** are kindly requested to remove their posters by **13:00 on Wednesday**. Authors of **Poster Session 2** may begin mounting their posters from **14:00 onwards on Wednesday**. Posters should be removed at the end of the second poster session on Thursday, or by Friday morning at the latest;
- Each poster board is numbered – please mount your poster on the board allocated to you, you will find poster lists indicating the number of your poster board. The hanging material will be provided at the poster area also.
- The dedicated poster boards are of A0 format portrait orientation

Instructions to Chairs

- Each session is chaired by two co-chairs, who will briefly introduce the speakers and ensure that the session runs according to the schedule;
- Chairs are requested to capture the main messages, recommendations, and key ideas emerging from the session and prepare a short summary to be presented during the Friday Session Summaries (11:30–13:30) in the Plenary Aula Duża.



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
